ERASMUS POLICY STATEMENT RCSMM

The RCSMM obtained the ECHE letter in 2014. The main objectives of the renewal of the ECHE charter are: to increase the number of mobility of students, teachers and staff, both incoming and outgoing, that have occurred up to this academic year at the RCSMM; internationalitation of the institution through the Erasmus + program. In recent years, the number of inter-institutional agreements has grown. We currently have more than eighty institutional agreements from more than twenty countries. We hope to continue strengthening ties with new institutions in order to further expand the agreements we currently have

The main activities carried out for the dissemination of the Erasmus + program are: updating the website; informational meetings with students; participation of a large part of the students in the incoming mobility ofteachers; dissemination of news information to students and teachers; face-to-face tests to be a candidate for a mobility study. The people who have participated so far in the Erasmus + program have been: students, teachers and staff, both incoming and outgoing, in recent years, the RCSMM has had around forty mobilities each academic year.

The experiences resulting from each mobility enrich each person individually and the center as a whole. With the renewal of the ECHE charter, the RCSMM intends to expand the number of mobilities and increase the internationalization of the institution. As a higher education center located in Madrid, the capital of Spain, we consider it essential that the RCSMM could grow more and more with the Erasmus + program.
